Arkansas State University-Newport Student Housing Frequently Asked Questions



How do I contact student housing?

The ASUN Office of Student Housing address is 7648 Victory Blvd., Newport, Arkansas and located in Walton Hall, Office 162. The phone number is 870-512-7859 and email is housing@asun.edu.

Who is eligible for ASUN Housing?

Students who are enrolled in at least 6 credit hours and 18 years of age can live in ASUN student housing.

When can I apply for housing?

Students may apply for housing after they have applied for admissions to the college. Students must be officially admitted to the college before approval for student housing. For more information about the admissions process, visit admissions@asun.edu.

What are the terms of the lease?

The student housing lease is a semester/academic year lease that outlines terms and conditions of living in ASUN housing. If a student chooses to leave ASUN housing prior to the end of the lease, they forfeit their deposit. More information may be found in the ASUN Housing Handbook.

Is a housing deposit required? When is it paid?

Yes, there is a \$100 housing deposit required when applying for student housing at ASUN. Currently students contact the student accounts cashier at onestop@asun.edu or call 870-512-7875 to submit deposit payment.

What are the housing rates?

Housing rate information is located on the ASUN website.

When will I know about my housing room assignment?

Housing assignments will be made once the student is fully admitted to the institution and housing payment, or payment arrangements have been made.

What is the roommate selection process?

The ASUN Office of Housing reviews each roommate preference profile when assigning roommates. While no match is guaranteed, the college makes every effort to provide matches based on the information in roommate profile from the housing application.

Can I submit a roommate's name?

Yes, students may submit a preferred roommate name on the housing application. Be sure and ask potential roommate to submit application and indicate roommate preference.

Am I guaranteed housing when I apply?

No, students are not guaranteed housing when applying. Applications are processed on a first come, first served basis. Students may be added to a waitlist for housing based on availability.

Once my room is assigned, can I request a room change?

Room changes are determined on availability. Changes to room assignments must be approved through the Office of Student Housing.

When is Move-In-Day for student housing?

Student Move-In-Day is scheduled for the Sunday before the first day of semester classes beginning.

Can I move in prior to Move-In-Day for student housing?

Arrangements for move-in-day may be adjusted depending on required start date of classes/required attendance for other events/activities.

Will my Financial Aid (FAFSA) pay for housing?

Financial Aid typically covers tuition, fees and books first and then housing depending on total aid available. Contact Financial Aid for more information at onestop@asun.edu.

When is the housing payment due?

Housing payments and lease agreements should be completed by August 1st of the fall semester and January 5 of the spring semester. Payment or payment arrangements must be made before moving into student housing.

Is there Internet connectivity available in student housing?

Wireless Internet access is provided in student housing.

Can I view rooms before moving in?

Students may schedule a tour of housing on room availability or view a virtual housing video/pictures located on the ASUN housing webpage.

Is a Meal Plan available? How do I request a meal plan?

Students have the option to add a meal plan. Contact the <u>bookstore@asun.edu</u> for more information regarding meal plans and costs.

Are Pets allowed in ASUN student housing?

No pets allowed in student housing.
